

ORDINANCE NO. 2020-3

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING CASEY POULETTE TO SUPPLY USED EQUIPMENT AND INSTALLATION SERVICES TO THE HARDY PUBLIC SAFETY DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, Arkansas Code 14.42.107 b(1) states "No alderman, council member, official, or municipal employee shall be interested, directly or indirectly, in the profits of any contract for furnishing supplies, equipment, or services to the municipality unless the governing body of the city has enacted an ordinance specifically permitting aldermen, council members, officials, or municipal employees to conduct business with the city and prescribing the extent of this authority."; and

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Hardy, Arkansas, has made a comprehensive study and review of the laws governing limitations of city officials being employed by or receiving funds from the City while serving as an official of the City of Hardy and,

WHEREAS, Mr. Casey Poulette, a police officer employed by the City of Hardy wishes to provided used equipment and technical installation services to the City of Hardy in 2019 and,

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council, Mr. Poulette was qualified to provide such to the City of Hardy and,

WHEREAS, Ark. Cod Ann. 14.42.107 may in some instances be interpreted as preventing such an agreement the City Council hereby waives an and all conflict,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HARDY, ARKANSAS:

Section 1. With the understanding that Casey Poulette was an employee of the City of Hardy, Arkansas, Casey Poulette is hereby authorized to conduct business with the City for 2019 in exchange for valuable consideration of \$5,050 dollars in exchange for the above-mentioned equipment and services.

Section 2. Emergency Clause. An emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Ordinance being necessary in the need to retain the employment of Casey Poulette as a police officer with the City of Hardy to continue to engage in the safe and efficient service and prevent disruption of service to the city residents and businesses and to ensure the health and safety and welfare.
