**WHEREAS**, the Spring River Dispensary, as a new developer of a facility in that area, desires to have access and benefit of future city services yet build a facility on Hwy 63N in August 2020; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Hardy has reviewed said memorandum and agrees to enter into said agreement with the Spring River Dispensary pursuant to the terms and conditions contained in the Memorandum of Understanding.

## Memorandum of Understanding

This memorandum serves to document the terms of agreement between the City of Hardy, Arkansas, and the Spring River Dispensary in consideration of City of Hardy expansion along Highway 63 N.

Whereas the City of Hardy is interested in growing the city boundary north along the Highway 63 N Corridor and thus providing public services and infrastructure to all businesses and residents in that annexed area, and

Whereas the Spring River Dispensary, as new developer of a facility in that area, desires to have access and benefit of future city services yet build a facility now on Hwy 63N in August 2020.

Be it therefore agreed to by the City of Hardy and Spring River Dispensary as to the following:

1. The City of Hardy will reimburse Spring River Dispensary for up to \$30,000 in documented expenses and interest associated with the acquisition of water services for their new facility on Highway 63N upon their successful annexation by the City of Hardy.
2. Spring River Dispensary agrees to be annexed by the City of Hardy.

The Mayor signs, per approval and authority per Resolution 2020-E granted August 4, 2020, by the Hardy City Council in regular session at the Hardy Civic Center 301 Main Street, Hardy, Arkansas.
